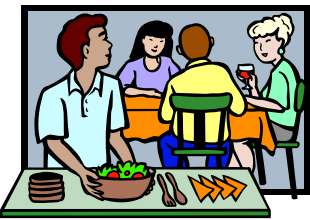

Nothing in this section, however, shall be so construed as to prohibit the regular parking of not more than two (2) automobiles but not including a pick-up truck with camper, in running condition and in a reasonable state of repair and preservation on any driveway permitted to be maintained on any of the lots hereby restricted.
